Opening Remarks: Roger Dunlap welcomed everyone to the meeting.

Reports:

- Social Action Commission (Andy Devito):
 - o Preparing grant proposals.
 - Discussed immigration reform.
 - Next plan to focus on Commission goals and objectives.
- Faith Formation Commission (Lauren Rau): Planned details for upcoming Ministry Fair ministry fair next weekend.
- Worship Commission (Louise Carter):
 - o Reviewed Lector, Server, and Eucharistic Minister (EMs) Ministries. All three have new leaders. New servers trained last week. Plan is in place to increase the number of Ems.
