

MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES

We've tried to indicate how much time is needed for each activity. Tell us how you want to share your God-given gift!

2 hours a week during program year:

TEACHER Needed for Grade 1 through grade 8.

Prepare lessons with provided curriculum, communicate with teaching team, attend training sessions, and teacher meetings.

TEACHING ASSISTANT Needed for Grade 1 through grade 8.

Check with teacher for tasks and be present before, during and after class.

SPECIAL EDUCATION ASST. Needed for Grade 1 through grade 8.

Provide teacher assistance for students with learning or physical disabilities. Experience working with special circumstances a plus.

SENIOR HIGH YOUTH MINISTRY

Be present at weekly sessions.

DESK/HALL MONITOR PERSON

Call absent students, monitor traffic pattern, building, and other duties as needed on Faith Formation evening/afternoon.

CHILD CARE PROVIDER

Weekday classes for teacher's children (Wednesday afternoons & Sunday mornings).

Once a month:

JUNIOR HIGH VOLUNTEERS

Assist Jr High Core Team, plan social and service activities for students in grades 6-8; and work at Kids for Christ events.

PUBLICITY

Write articles regarding Faith Formation news for the parish bulletin, area newspapers, SPIRIT newsletter, etc.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Take pictures of classes, special events, etc. for bulletin boards, parish history books, and parish monitor.

LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

Help maintain and improve our learning space.

CHILD CARE GIVER

- 1) Nursery during 8:30 or 11:00 am Sunday Mass.
- 2) During R.C.I.A. sessions on Sundays
- 3) During parish meetings/gatherings

SHOPPING CERTIFICATES

Help sell shopping certificates after weekend Masses. Proceeds to benefit Faith Formation.

1 ½ hours twice a month during program year:

CHILDREN'S CATECHUMENATE

Share Faith with children who are becoming Catholic. Help with learning activities on weekday evenings or Scripture sharing on Sunday mornings.

As needed:

GENERATIONS OF FAITH TEAM

Help plan seasonal activities for parishioners of all ages to enjoy learning together.

SENIOR HIGH VOLUNTEERS

Help plan social and service activities for students in grades 9-12.

WORK AT HOME

Work with office staff on projects according to your skills and interest. E.g.: typing, making phone calls, stuffing envelopes, sewing, woodworking.

HELP WITH RECEPTIONS

Help set-up and clean-up for sacrament receptions.

BAKER

Provide cookies or other food for sacrament receptions or other special occasions.

SACRAMENT TEAM

Help with special activities for those receiving sacraments: First Reconciliation, First Communion (Jesus Day), Confirmation, etc.

VIDEOGRAPHER

Take videos of special events

ADULT VOLUNTEERS

Planning adult formation opportunities, phone calls to adults for various programs, service, reminders, etc.
