• Review Previous Meeting Minutes (Roger Dunlap): PAC members approved the Meeting Minutes from January 16, 2018.

Reports:

Vision Committee (Meghann Naveau):

 Meghann distributed and reviewed with PAC members the final draft of the Vision Committee's developed identity statements. This document defines a common theme of St. Francis of Assisi Parish. It is the result of continual gathering and organizing of parish members' feedback amid the various events that took place throughout our parish pilgrimage.

Vision Committee (Ann Moell):

- Feedback from surveys has been developed into a common theme and is ready to roll out when our new pastor arrives.
- o Dates in April and May are being tagged for the selection process of new commission members.

Social Action Commission (Dan Driskell):

Dan announced several events on the social calendar: The Muslim Catholic Dialogue May 1st, 8th and 22nd; the movie <u>Outkast</u> will be shown at Kroc Center 3/21; Weaver's Meeting 3/26; Ministry Fair August 19th; Jean Eagon presentation at St. Luke on <u>Choosing Hope</u> (Jericho Journey) on May 12th.

• Faith Formation Commission (Anna Monnett):

- The Abide Leadership Conference for Teens was discussed along with youth volunteer opportunities and Jr.
 High Stations of the Cross.
- Knights of Columbus and Men's Club will offer scholarships of \$50 each up to \$500.
- Knights of Columbus and Men's Club need youth volunteers to help with mulch delivery 4/21/18.

Worship Commission (Skip Fromm):

- o The placement of the Stations of the Cross was decided to have six on the left and eight on the right.
- o Eight ushers were trained on the AED and further training for others is being planned.
- Needed positions for Easter Masses is being planned.

- Finance Council is in the process of organizing current paper documents to be transferred into an electronic system.
