PASTORAL ADVISORY COUNCIL (PAC) MINUTES - October 16, 2018

The meeting commenced at 8:00 pm.

- Review Previous Meeting Minutes (Louise Carter): PAC members approved the Meeting Minutes from September 18, 2018.
- New Members (Louise Carter): Louise welcomed new PAC member Deb Franz.
- Staff Report (additions):
 - Father Brian
 - Heard confessions for Alter high, Kairos
 - New Processional cross for mass
 - Question raised two months ago during PAC meeting regarding need for a new cross
 - Search commenced; St. Mary's in Urbana responded; We acquired a beautiful crucifix valued at \$3200 for \$400

Reports:

- Social Action Commission (Dan Driskell):
 - There was no formal meeting; informal meeting occurred with Dan & Andy supporting Chuck (commission chair) by talking through goals
 - Chuck, Skip and Andy will meet in early November to further discuss goals and planning for the commission; primary goal is to grow membership
- Faith Formation Commission:
 - Staff not present.
 - XLT going well with slow growth
 - o Goal to get the Parish Mission statement in all classrooms
 - How to get volunteers: solutions (i.e. personal invitation; several other ideas discussed)
 - o Recommendation: when marketing events (i.e. Generations of Faith), share what the event will cover and what age group it is geared toward
- Worship Commission (Ann Moell):
 - Ministry Fair October 27th/28th
 - They are currently tabling the plan to complete the Commission charter while they align on what commitment will be expected of members; members are reluctant to commit to 3 year term, so they may consider limiting it to a 1 year commitment
 - o Invited several new members, no commitments yet

- Chair of the Commission is committed through June; no vice chair currently; like Social Action & Faith
 Formation, Worship Commission has a focus on membership/leadership of the Commission
- o Several ideas discussed to increase engagement with/on the commission
- o Fr. Brian looking into more confession time (Saturday morning not ideal for everyone)
 - How to cover all the times that people would be able to go
 - Several options: Lunch, CCD, after dinner, etc.; weekdays and weekend
 - Concern: big commitment for Father, what if called away (i.e. funeral); lots of volunteers for funeral, so this shouldn't be an issue
- o Father Gaeke leaving; Fr. Brian will be doing all masses for the next month
- o Liturgical Planning Team; to help plan out the liturgical year (holidays, environment, music, etc.)
 - They will meet quarterly
 - If interested in joining, talk to Michelle Nehrbass
 - 2 main purposes of team:
 - Assist Michelle & Deacon Chris
 - o Empower parishioners to be involved in planning liturgies, etc.
- o We need to identify where stations should be placed; Deacon Chris to work with the Commission

• Finance Council (Fred Wootan):

- Roof repair cost offset by donation from one family
- End of year report discussed
- Someone in the gathering space from finance after mass on previous weekends
 - One question from parishioner: How to automatic withdrawal donate to parish; this is possible
 - Feedback: place financial reports in bulletin and then be available for questions the next weekend so that people have the opportunity to digest it before asking questions
- Finance Council rotates every year; 5 year maximum number of years to be on council

• Youth (Delaney Smith):

- Focus changed name to Ignite
- o XLT adoration 11/11 at 7pm
- o Ignite will participate in Generations of Faith service project next week
- o Delaney will be on the Committee for the proposal for the John Paul II Room
 - Looking for good cross section of representatives (youth, young adult, etc.)
 - Ensure that Virtus is a consideration since high school/youth will need adult volunteers while utilizing the room

Business (Deacon Chris Rauch):

- Looking into pavers; gathering more info from vendors and what approach to take
- o Emergency Response Plan; still a draft, looking to get it finalized
- Stations of the Cross Plaque; explains how we obtained them (background info, etc.); looking for feedback
- A few cases of people coming to our parish soliciting money on parish grounds
 - We need to communicate our Policy on this to the parish
 - We can give them gift cards or refer them to St. Vincent DePaul
 - Send them to the police department (transient that needs gas money)

Open Forum/Concerns:

PAC representatives in gathering space scheduled same weekend as Worship Ministry Fair

- Decision made to skip this month
- o Feedback provided to PAC regarding excessive noise made during mass
 - Various perspectives shared; aligned that whatever action is taken, we do not want it to make anyone not feel welcome
 - What is a respectful noise level during and prior to mass
 - o Children making noise; when is it respectful to go to the gathering space or nursery
 - Adults having discussions in pews prior to mass; discussions can happen in gathering space so that those who would like quiet prayer time can have it
- O Slat wall for flyers in gathering space; when will this be in place? Where can Thanksgiving boxes be placed? They will need to be placed somewhere else going forward.
