Registrations will be first come first serve.

There are **only 20 spots available** for students.

Each participant MUST have a parent or adult representative (over 21) donate one full day on the work site. This will include driving participants to and from the work site and supervising during the workday. Adults who help MUST be Safe Parish certified.

We will begin each daily prayer held in the chapel in the Parish Center. The pickup location each day will be in the Parish Center Parking lot.

Your **\$30 registration fee** covers all of the expenses for the week (tools, paint, paint brushes, etc.), your t-shirt, bowling, pizza and drinks on Friday, and if we end up having a little extra, we donate it to the organization we work with (Rebuilding Together Dayton).

Participants will bring their lunches and a water bottle. We will have a cooler for lunches and a 5-gallon water cooler to refill water bottles! Participants will arrive and return back to Incarnation by way of parent transportation. If we run into rain, the schedule may have to be altered or that day could be canceled. We have to play that by ear. We are sorry for any inconvenience this may cause.

The participants will also have the opportunity to build on their faith and friendships. Each day will include opening and closing faith circles with prayer and faith sharing.

On Friday, we will only work a half day, then head to Poleking Lanes to have a pizza lunch and do some bowling to celebrate the week of service and build fellowship! Pick up will still be at 2:30pm at Incarnation.
