- Liturgy Section -

6 Servers will enter down the side aisle solemnly and sit in their chairs beside the altar.

STAND

The Clergy process down the main aisle in silence. (ushers bring the lights up) ALL KNEEL as the clergy prostrate themselves in front of the altar.

STAND

#2 (RM) to Presider

OPENING PRAYER in Roman Missal (omit "Let us Pray") P. 169

#2 (RM) returns to their seat

SIT

FIRST READING: Isaiah 52: 13-53:12 (Lector 1)

RESPONSORIAL PSALM: Psalm 31

SECOND READING: Hebrews 4:14-16; 5:7-9 (Lector 2)

STAND

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION:

Lectors move into place during the Gospel Acclamation. Lector 1 (Narrator) invites congregation to sit by reading the following:

LECTOR 1:

"During the reading of the Lord's Passion,
we invite you to remain standing as we
unite ourselves with the Lord's suffering.
Of course, those who find it hard to remain standing
for long periods can freely sit down if necessary."

GOSPEL- Read in parts from Breaking Bread

Lord's Passion found in Breaking Bread. (BB page 109)

N. - Narrator (Lector 1) reading from the ambo

† - Christ (Presider) reading from the presider chair

V - Voice (Lector 2) reading from the lectern

C. - Crowd (All others)

THE LORD'S PASSION: John 18:1 - 19:42

21. The narrative of the Lord's Passion is read without candles and without incense, with no greeting or signing of the book. It is read by a Deacon or, if there is no Deacon, by a Priest.

It may also be read by readers, with the part of Christ, if possible, reserved to a Priest.

SIT

HOMILY

#2 (RM) to Presider

Solemn Intercessions Roman Missal p.171

Deacon leads using his own copy at the Ambo:

Deacon Chris will chant: "Let us Kneel - Let us Stand"

Presider - Intercession Prayers in Roman Missal P.171

#2 (RM) returns to seat

Veneration of the Cross Roman Missal p 184

Deacon goes with #1 and #6 to the Vestibule. (larger servers with muscle!)

#3 and #4 will follow to carry the candles! Ushers assist with the lighting of the candles

Deacon brings the cross forward, accompanied by

#1 and #6 to help carry the cross, and #3 and #4 with lighted candles.

While processing with the cross, the Deacon sings (three times) at the entrance, middle, and the altar area of the sanctuary

Deacon Sung "BEHOLD THE WOOD OF THE CROSS,
ON WHICH HUNG THE SALVATION OF THE WORLD."

CHOIR Responds with ALL: "Come, let us adore"

All: KNEEL

Veneration of the cross

Assembly songs: Gather at the Cross, Mary by the Cross, Thy Will Be Done, Elegy, Jesus Remember Me, Pieta, etc.

The cross is lowered in place onto the two podiums by Deacon and #1 and #6 as Fr. Brian and Fr. Joseph venerate the cross.

#3 and #4 with the tall lighted candles stand flanking the head of the cross. The Deacon and Servers then venerate the cross.

#2 and #5 attend to the cross as the congregation venerates.

#2 and #5 wipe the areas of the cross that are touched by the congregation using purificators

Deacon will notify #1 and #6 when he is ready to place the cross in the stand.

Together you place the cross in the stand.

#3 and #4 follow and then place lighted candles on both sides of the cross Deacon returns to his chair

All Servers proceed to their seats

Holy communion

#3 and #4 go with Deacon to place of Repose.
#3 and #4 assist Deacon with the Humeral Veil if needed, and prepare to process in with the

Assembly song:

When Jesus Wept

The servers prepare the altar with the assistance of Fr. Joseph.

#2 and #5 bring the altar cloth and corporal to the altar and assist with dressing the altar.

#1 and #6 bring the Roman Missal, bowls and one purificator to the altar (not the tray).

The cross pedestals are moved to the side by the ushers

Blessed Sacrament and Processional candles.

PROCESSION

Once the altar is prepared, the Deacon, wearing the humeral veil and accompanied by #3 and #4 (Candle bearers), transfer the Blessed Sacrament from the vesting sacristy to the altar.

The assembly and other ministers are standing.

#3 and #4 place candles in stands on both sides of the ALTAR (Extra candle bases must be in place!)

#3 and #4 return to their seats

Deacon places ciborium on the altar, the Presider goes to the altar and genuflects

Presider - Uses Roman Missal for Holy Communion Lord's Prayer (is recited)

Eucharistic Ministers move into place behind the altar <u>during the Lord's Prayer</u>. There is no sign of peace...

DISTRIBUTION OF COMMUNION

Song: What Wondrous Love is This BB-484

Meditation: Nearer My God to Thee

Once all have received Holy Communion, the presider places the ciborium on the altar.

Deacon is assisted with the Humeral veil

Deacon accompanied by #3 and #4 with the candles <u>from the altar</u>, return the Blessed Sacrament to the Chapel of repose.

Fr. Joseph retrieves the RM and returns to the chair.

The servers folds and remove the altar cloth – #6 places it on the servers table

Presider returns to his chair

Deacon and Servers #3 and #4 do not return from Place of Repose

-#2 (RM) to Presider when he stands

Presider - Prayer after Communion - Roman Missal P. 192

Presider - Prayer over the people - Roman Missal P. 192

And all, after genuflecting to the Cross, depart in silence

The altar is stripped by the servers in a solemn and quiet fashion.

Two lit candles may remain at the foot of the cross

The church is locked at 9:00pm

- CHECKLIST SECTION -

All arrive on Good Friday NLT 6:45 pm - Solemn service, we are quiet All Ministers check in as usual

Cushions for servers to kneel on should be in place

2 tall candles(ext. added, & a lighter near the large cross in gathering space

Large cross located in the gathering space(ushers assist with candles)

Two candle bases located at large cross destination.

Two candle bases located on both sides of the altar.

A basket available at doors for those bringing donations.

Maintain silence after service/collect books

Sacristans:

Ensure that the Eucharistic Minister Captain has shown up and is prepared. No decorations of any kind, the altar is bare, no cross, candles, or cloths. Humeral veil ready in vesting sacristy

Altar cloth, corporal, Roman Missal on servers table Four purificators on credence table for wiping of cross (2 primary/2 spares) Breaking Bread books, and Worship aids in place for clergy and servers There are five distributing the Eucharist

Ushers:

Hand out Holy Week books as people arrive. This is a solemn service, so all are quiet as we enter and prepare for the liturgy. Gift bearers are not needed. Ensure Basket in place for donations - an usher should hold the basket at the end of the service and allow donations to be placed as people exit. The lights should be at setting #7 prior to the clergy entering; upon their

entrance the lights should be turned to setting #11 to signal the start of the service.

Help the servers light their candles in the gathering space, when they are preparing to process in with the Cross - there should be a lighter nearby.

Lectors:

Two Lectors Scheduled:

1st reading - Lector 1, 2nd reading - Lector 2,

Gospel Narrator - Lector 1, Gospel Voice - Lector 2.

No procession at the beginning of the service.


Lectors move into place during the Gospel Acclamation

Narrator invites congregation to sit prior to the Gospel (See text on page 1)

Eucharistic Minister:

Check in as usual, No procession at the beginning of the service. Eucharistic Ministers assemble behind the altar as usual during the Lord's Prayer. (There is no sign of peace)

Good Friday Distribution stations are as follows



H = EM for Host, P=Priest, D=Deacon

Maintenance:

Two pedestals for wooden cross placed in front of altar. Cross base in place and weighted down Ensure the parking lot lights are on for safety(timer?). Lock doors @ 10:15pm.

Servers: Notes are within the Master Document
