# SENIOR HIGH YOUTH MINISTRY

Be present at weekly sessions.

# DESK/HALL MONITOR PERSON

Call absent students, monitor traffic pattern, building, and other duties as needed on Faith Formation evening/afternoon.

# CHILD CARE PROVIDER

Weekday classes for teacher's children (Wednesday afternoons & Sunday mornings).

# JUNIOR HIGH VOLUNTEERS

Assist Jr High Core Team, plan social and service activities for students in grades 6-8; and work at Kids for Christ events.

### PHOTOGRAPHY
