**Blessed be the great Mother of God, Mary most holy**

**Blessed be her holy and Immaculate Conception**

**Blessed be her glorious Assumption**

**Blessed be the name of Mary, Virgin and Mother**

**Blessed be St. Joseph, her most chaste spouse**

**Blessed be God in His angels and in His Saints.**
